Marching Through Time

Heritage Village, Cincinnati, Ohio 11-12 June 2022

This is our first appearance not only at this site, but also in the Cincinnati area. This is a Timeline, with units from a number of historical periods, and the primary focus of this event will be on Saturday. We will have our own area to set up a camp and perform both camp-life as well as our usual lineup of lecture/demonstrations. It is my hope that you will plan to stay over for Sunday, and we can work on our impressions and drill, wrapping up about noon.

Some of the demos/activities you might consider are:

1. Sewing; repairing a garment or piece of equipment
2. Cleaning your musket using 18th c. materials
3. Cooking; either simple firecakes or perhaps something more complicated
4. Shaving one and other (a very dull blade and lots of lather)
5. Create a display in your tent of what how it would appear being shared by 6 men
6. Laying out all the things in your pack in preparation for a march
7. Gaming

These are suggestions to get you started. Let's create a living, working camp. I know you have many fine ideas of your own.

Meals: You are on your own for meals, but a voucher will be provided for you to use at the food vendors on site on Saturday. They ask that you use them before the end of the day for the vendors.

If you can only make it on Sunday, I would say that unless you live very near, it may not be worth your driving time to drive several hours for Sunday only.
